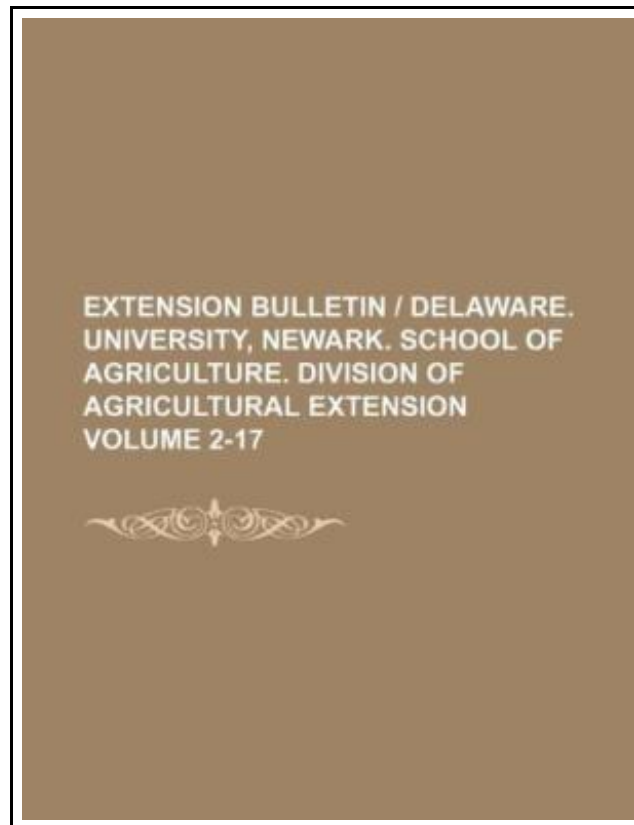

As the population of Wilmington increased, creating a greater demand for the more ready edible foods, the farmers began to supplement the general crops with the production of truck crops, fruits, dairy products, and poultry products. The survey showed that in 1925, truck crops and fruits amounted to about one fifth of the total farm sales, poultry products about one-fifth, and dairy products about onethird. These items brought in \$2,547 of the \$3,654 total receipts per farm in 1925. Topography.--The topography of northern New Castle County varies from rolling to hilly. Its elevation ranges from about 100 to 400 feet above sea level. The slopes are not, as a rule, so steep as to prevent cultivation or to cause excessive erosion, but the freedom from erosion is, in part, due to the mellow, absorptive nature of the soil. Only nine per cent of the land is non-tillable. Climate.--The winters are not severe and the summers are not excessively hot. The mean temperature for the winter is 30.8 dedegrees F. and for the summer is 72.7 degrees; the mean annual temperature is 52.4 degrees. Temperatures of 100 degrees above and 12 degrees below zero F. have been recorded, but these extremes are not frequent. Owing to the geographic position of the area the humidity is high, a condition which increases the oppressiveness of the heat during the summer months.
